



## Postgraduate English Language Requirements

The following English Language qualification and tests are acceptable for entry to the Voice Study Centre. **Tests must be taken in person at an approved test centre**. If you are taking an English language qualification that is not specified below, please contact Admissions@voicestudycentre.com for advice on whether it is acceptable for entry. The Levels below are the minimum entry requirements for admission.

## **Shelf Life of Test/Qualifications**

For all of the tests listed in the table below **except Pearson Test of English (PTE) Academic and TOEFL** we can accept a test taken up to 3 years before the start of the course you are applying for.

**PTE Academic and TOEFL** tests must be verifiable online. Please note that verification is only available online within 3 years of the date of test for PTE Academic and within 2 years of the date of the test for TOEFL.

## **Exemptions**

If you are a national or graduate of a UK Home Office defined majority English-speaking country, you may not need to take an English test to evidence your proficiency if they fit into one of the categories **below**.

Applicants from outside these countries with a UK degree equivalent qualification, do not need to demonstrate English language competence if they can provide proof that the qualification was instructed in English.

(1) Students who have previously completed an academic qualification equivalent to a UK degree which was taught in one of the following countries ('majority Englishspeaking' countries). Students must have graduated no more than five years before their course start date at Essex.
